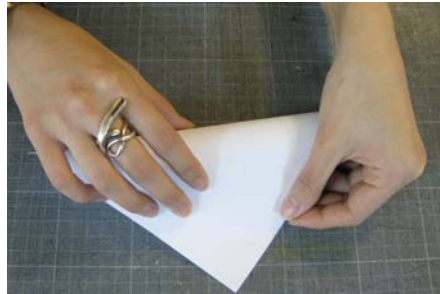
## The Windmill How-To

### You will need...

a square piece of thick paper, a straw, a pin fastener/split pin, hole puncher, glue, oil pastels and watercolour, and a pair of scissors.



**1** Fold the paper into 4, so that when you undo the folds, there are 4 equal triangles.



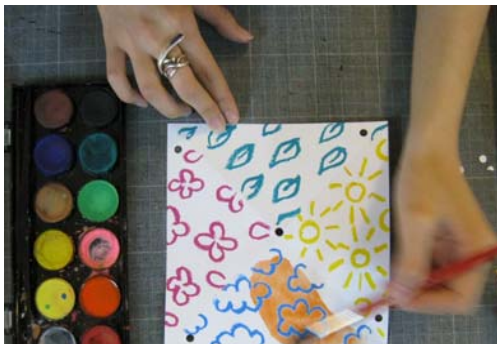
**2** Punch a hole in the corner so that when opened, it forms a circle in the centre of the paper.



**3** Then punch a hole at the same side of each triangle.



**4** Create some patterns on both sides. Each triangle can have a different pattern. Be as creative as you like.



**5** Using scissors, cut along the crease lines, to slightly after the midway point of each crease to the centre.



**6** Fold each corner to the centre, so that all the holes meet to form only one hole, securing it with glue.



**7** Cut a slit in the straw. Fit the fastener through the hole in the windmill, and then through the straw before fastening it. Done!



**Tadaa!!! A pretty windmill spinning in the wind!**
